## **Student removed from register**

On 23 April 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Miss Olessia Charak of Moscow, Russian Federation. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them in her exam attempt, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Charak should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610.00 and the decision be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to the student by name.
