A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Thursday 16 October 2008, at the General Council of the Bar, 289-293 High Holborn, London WC1V 7HZ. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Four cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Concerns an allegation that a member having been disciplined by another professional body is liable to disciplinary action.

CASE 2 Concerns an allegation that a member failed to provide a competent and diligent service contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Professional Competence and Due Care.

CASE 3 Concerns an allegation that a member failed to comply with an order of the Admissions and Licensing Committee.

CASE 4 Concerns an allegation that a member acted as a company auditor when he did not hold a valid auditing certificate.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
