A hearing of ACCA's Appeal Committee will take place at 10.00 am on 22 October 2008, at The Lincoln's Centre, 18 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London, WC2A 3ED. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Four cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a student who is guilty of misconduct, in that he failed to act with integrity in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them.
- CASE 2 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation against a student who is guilty of misconduct, in that contrary to Examination Regulations, he took to his desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised material to gain unfair advantage in the examination contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
- CASE 3 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation against a student who is guilty of misconduct and a breach of regulations by sending emails containing confidential and sensitive client information to a third party, contrary to the fundamental principle of Confidentiality.

CASE 4 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation against a student who is guilty of misconduct contrary to Examination Regulations, she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use the unauthorised material to gain an unfair advantage in the examination contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Appeal Committee.
