A hearing of ACCA's Appeal Committee will take place at 10.00 am on 30 September 2008, at Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB . The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning six allegations of a member who is guilty of misconduct, in that he failed to act with integrity, conducted his practice improperly, inefficiently or incompetently to such an extent or on such a number of occasions as to bring discredit to himself and to the Association, and committed a breach of regulations.

CASE 2 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation against a student who is guilty of misconduct, in that she was convicted of 2 counts of doing an act tending and intending to pervert the course of public justice.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Appeal Committee.
